Certification Description	Provides proof of concept and application of continuous improvement project that demonstrates the ability to function as a team member or leader and can successfully collect, organize and understand data necessary in the use of a Six Sigma Project. Techniques include project charters, problem solving techniques, basic control charting, process mapping, data types, Pareto charts, cost justification and project selection.
Prerequisites	None
Certification Requirements	2 hour proctored written exam Project: Initiation of 1 project that demonstrates the proper use of six sigma tools and concepts. Documentation must include the submission of a Project Charter and tools necessary to complete the Define and Measure phase of the project. This will include at a minimum, as is process map, control chart and Pareto analysis.
