Degree Requirements	<p>The completion of the Bachelor of Science: Quality Management degree is a culmination of all project found in the Level II courses. In order to qualify for the Bachelor of Science Degree, the student must have satisfactorily completed all Level II courses and exams. In addition, two electives must be included. These must include Safety and Tech Report Writing. If these electives have been successfully completed in the past, then two other electives may be substituted.</p> <p>To complete the degree requirements, students must submit an overall summary of their findings, based upon their project work obtained during the certification phase, in the proper writing style. The minimum number of pages generally accepted for this project will be 50 pages. This project will be reviewed by a member of the faculty for proper format and content.</p>
